

STORY OF THE MEMORIAL CONTRACT PROJECT

at the National WWI Museum and Memorial

Open to graduate students or advanced undergraduate students

The Curatorial Affairs Department at the National WWI Museum and Memorial is hosting several temporary contract positions centered on the upcoming Story of the Memorial exhibition. These positions are hybrid and require some local travel in the Kansas City area. The project is expected to last between four and six weeks. Contractors will be compensated at an hourly rate for their work plus certain expenses like mileage if approved. Contractors are responsible for any tax implications from these payments, if any. There are no additional compensation components afforded with this opportunity

Preferred qualifications include experience conducting primary and secondary source research, data entry and analysis, and strong communication skills. Prior knowledge of World War I is not required.
